ROBIN HOOD

People have been telling stories about Robin Hood for over 700 years. In all the stories he is an outlaw who dresses in green and lives in Sherwood Forest with his companions, known ' Merry MEN". Together they steal things from the rich and give them to the poor to help them. They are excellent archers who are very good at hiding from their enemy, the Sheriff of Nottingham. Other important charactèrs in the stories are Maid Marian and some of Robin's men . Little John, called Little as a joke because he is so big and strong, Friar Tuck, the monk with an enormous appetite, and Will Scarlet.

But the story of Robin Hood has not always been the same. The earliest versions were ballads that the people in England liked to listen to. In these stories, Robin is a common man who helps the poor to protect their land. But in books and plays that were written later Robin is a wealthy man who has had his land taken away from him unfairly by the Sherriff. These stories end with Robin getting his land back and marrying Maid Marian.

Since then, the story of Robin Hood has appeared in comics, films and TV. Kevin Costner played Robin in the 1991 film, Robin Hood, Prince of Thieves and Russel Crowe starred with Cate Blanchett in the 2010 film, Robin Hood The film is very dramatic, with spectacular battle scenes and a romantic ending.

So, did Robin Hood really exist? It is impossible to know for sure. It seems that every generation invents its own Robin Hood. It's the perfect example of how a good story lives on and on
